Susan Eernisse Cherub/Primary Choir Clinician

Susan Eernisse is editor of *The Chorister*, the journal for church musicians published by Choristers Guild. She earned her Bachelor of Music and Master of Education degrees from Berry College. She completed Levels I, II, and III of Orff-Schulwerk Certification at Shorter University and the University of Kentucky. Susan taught elementary music in public and private schools for 20 years, and has also taught courses in music education at the college level. She currently serves as Children's Music Coordinator at the First Baptist Church of Carrollton, Georgia. Susan is a veteran writer and freelance editor of children's music curriculum materials, including work for Growing in Grace Children's Music Curriculum. She is a respected children's choir clinician, and has served on the faculties of children's music camps and festivals for many years.

Elizabeth Shepley Junior Choir Clinician

Elizabeth Shepley enjoyed 16 years as a conductor, teacher and artistic director of the Northfield Youth Choirs, and 26 years as director of children's and youth music at the House of Hope Presbyterian Church Choir School in St. Paul and at Bethel Lutheran Church in Northfield. Liz holds a MA in Music Education with a Kodály emphasis (University of St. Thomas), a BA in Music Education (Concordia College, Moorhead, MN) and certifications in both Kodály and Orff-Schulwerk. Further music study has taken her to the Institut Jaques-Dalcroze in Switzerland, the Orff Institute in Austria, The Kodály Institute in Hungary, and the Royal School of Church Music in England. She has taught music education in public and private schools.

Liz has chaired inner city music programs in Minneapolis and St. Paul, has served as President of the Twin Cities Chapter of Choristers Guild, as a board member of MN-ACDA and as adjunct professor at Luther Seminary. She has led conferences and festival choirs nationwide, and choirs under her direction have performed across the United States, Canada and Europe. Liz loves to bike, cook, read, golf & travel, and together with her husband, Bob, enjoys keeping up with her four adult sons.

Victor C. Johnson Middle School Clinician

Victor C. Johnson, a native of Dallas, Texas, is the School Choral Editor for SING!, the educational publishing division of Choristers Guild. A prolific composer and arranger, he has over 350 choral works, vocal solo books, and keyboard collections currently in print. Mr. Johnson attended the University of Texas at Arlington where he majored in music education with a concentration in organ. While attending UTA, he served as student conductor of the university's choral ensembles and opera workshop accompanist.

From 2000-2018, Mr. Johnson was the choral director at the Ft. Worth Academy of Fine Arts (FWAFA). At FWAFA, Victor directed the Academy Singers, Academy Men's Choir and was Artistic Director of the Singing Girls of Texas and Children's Choir of Texas. Victor is in demand as a guest conductor, adjudicator, and clinician for music educators and students throughout the United States. He has conducted All-State and Regional Honor choirs in Texas, California, Georgia, Oklahoma, Louisiana, Oregon, Missouri, Nebraska, Kansas, Nevada, and Kentucky. His own choirs have performed at the Texas Music Educators Association Convention in 2011 and 2014 as well as the American Choral Directors Association- Southwest Division conference in March, 2016.

Victor currently serves as Minister of Worship and Arts at Shiloh Baptist Church in Plano, Texas, a position he has held since 2007. His professional affiliations include: American Choral Directors Association, Texas Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, Texas Choral Directors Association, ASCAP, and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Inc.

<u>Todd Arant</u> Youth Choir Clinician

Todd Arant serves as Director of Traditional Worship Arts at Apex United Methodist Church in Apex, NC, where he oversees a vibrant worship arts ministry including vocal and instrumental choirs for adults, youth, and children. Todd holds degrees from Furman University (Bachelor of Music), Emory University (Master of Music), and The Institute for Worship Studies (Doctor of Worship Studies). He serves as the President of the North Carolina Chapter for the Fellowship of United Methodists in Music and Worship Arts, and he also serves on the national board of directors for Choristers Guild. Todd is married to Allison and a proud father of three children: Clarkson, Anna Rast, and Sims.

Shannon Jeffreys Adult Choir Clinician

Dr. Shannon Jeffreys is Associate Professor and Director of Choral Activities at Georgia Southern University in Statesboro, Georgia. Her focus is the *Southern Chorale*, teaching in the undergraduate and graduate conducting and music education curriculums, along with directing *Southern Gentlemen*. In 2015, she received the College of Liberal Arts and Social Science's *Award of Distinction in Teaching*. Dr. Jeffreys has led these choirs in five international choral competitions and two national competitions where the choirs won significant awards. In 2019, she received the conductor's award from the Ave Verum International Choral Competition in Baden, Austria. Choirs under her direction have also been featured at multiple state and national conferences, most recently performing at the National Collegiate Choral Organization's National Conference.

Dr. Jeffreys maintains an active schedule as a presenter, adjudicator, lecturer and guest conductor from secondary to collegiate institutions throughout the United States and serves as an International choral adjudicator with *Meeting Music*. She serves on the Artistic Committee for All National Choral Festival and recently published in ACDA's *ChorTeach*. In 2015, she launched the first *Southern Invitational High School Choral Competition* that is now the first regional choral festival affiliate for *Music for All National Choir Festival presented by Yamaha*.

Before coming to Georgia Southern, Jeffreys served as Director of Vocal Studies at Erskine College and Theological Seminary. She holds degrees in music performance and conducting from Birmingham Southern College, the University of Mississippi, and the University of South Carolina.

Cherubs should be picked up PROMPTLY AT 10:40 AM in the old gym. Primary Choir members will be escorted to their next rehearsal by the counselors. Junior Choir members will join Children's Church at 10:20 AM after their rehearsal and will be escorted to their next activity by the counselors.
