2020 Recreation Information, Pricing & Group Size Limits

Adventure/Challenge Activities

Leap of Faith

Participants climb a 20-ft. telephone pole, leap to tag a hanging element, and descend gently to the ground. All adventure activities are conducted with the utmost attention to safety. All necessary equipment such as harnesses, carabineers, helmets, and ropes are provided, managed, fitted, and set up by our trained and experienced staff.

Minimum requirements: 8 years of age and must be able to fit into our harnesses- NO special rigging can be allowed. Individuals weighing more than 250 lbs. and women who are pregnant may not participate in the Leap of Faith due to safety concerns.

Cost \$285 for unlimited use for each session. Maximum of 20 participants.

New Heights Dual Zipline

Participants climb to a platform where a trained staff member clips them to a zipline pulley. From the platform, there is an exciting ride along the cable that provides an excellent aerial view of our recreation areas. Our new zipline is a dual zipline, so participants can side-by-side zip with a friend. All adventure activities are conducted with the utmost attention to safety. All necessary equipment such as harnesses, carabineers, lobster claw clips, helmets, and ropes are provided, managed, fitted, and set up by our trained and experienced staff.

Minimum requirements: 8 years of age and must be able to fit into our harnesses- NO special rigging can be allowed. Individuals weighing more than 250 lbs. and women who are pregnant may not participate in the zipline due to safety concerns.

Cost \$495 for each session. Maximum of 35 participants.

Climbing Tower

Bonclarken's 45-foot climbing tower simulates the popular activity of rock climbing. Participants have the option to scale a climbing wall with options ranging from very easy (mouseholes) to very challenging. All adventure activities are conducted with the utmost attention to safety. All necessary equipment such as harnesses, carabineers, helmets, and ropes are provided, managed, fitted, and set up by our trained and experienced staff.

Minimum requirements: 6 years of age and must be able to fit into our harnesses- NO special rigging can be allowed. Individuals weighing more than 250 lbs. and women who are pregnant may not participate in the climbing tower due to safety concerns.

Costs
 \$285 for two climbing routes available for each session. Maximum 30 participants.
 \$335 for three climbing routes available for each session. Maximum 50 participants.
 \$410 for four climbing routes available for each session. Maximum 70 participants.
 \$760 for full access for each session including the lift and two climbing routes of choice.

Indoor Climbing Wall

The indoor climbing wall is generally only available to groups that have already reserved the Youth Activity Building and have scheduled this activity at least three weeks in advance.

Our indoor climbing wall gives participants have the option to scale three different climbing routes ranging from easy to challenging. All adventure activities are conducted with the utmost attention to safety. All necessary equipment such as harnesses, carabineers, helmets, and ropes are provided, managed, fitted, and set up by our trained and experienced staff.

Minimum requirements: 6 years of age and must be able to fit into our harnesses- NO special rigging can be allowed. Individuals weighing more than 250 lbs. and women who are pregnant may not participate in the indoor climbing wall due to safety concerns.

Costs
 \$285 for two belayers & three climbing routes available for each session. Maximum 30 participants
 \$335 for three belayers & three climb routes available for each session. Maximum 50 participants.
 \$115 additional cost to include bouldering wall per indoor climbing wall session.
 (Requires trained Bonclarken rec staff member to set up/monitor)
 \$135 for unlimited use of bouldering wall only for each session.
 (Requires trained Bonclarken rec staff member to set up/monitor)

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Other Recreation Activities

Paintball

Seasonally available March-November

Participants play on two teams of up to 5 people each in an exciting game of last man standing. Bonclarken provides extensive safety orientation; paintball markers (guns) and paintballs appropriate for use on our wooded course; and protective equipment including full face masks.

Minimum age: 12 years of age. Participants should wear long pants; hiking, tennis shoes, or other close-toed athletic shoes are required - expect clothes to get very dirty. Outside equipment and paint is not permitted.

Cost

Minimum of 10 participants \$31 per person per session. 1 staff member & gear for 10 provided. \$53 per box of paintballs (2000 paintballs per box)—allow one box of paintballs per 10 participants. Groups will meet in back corner of athletic field for orientation.

Boating

Available Memorial Day-Labor Day during posted hours

Participants can use paddleboats or funyaks to navigate Bonclarken Lake. In order to use funyaks, participants must be at least 12 years old. All ages may ride paddleboats or aquabikes; however, children under age 8 must be accompanied by an adult. Our trained and experienced lifeguards manage and guard the waterfront, check boats out to participants, provide extensive safety orientation, and fit participants for personal flotation devices (PFDs). Safety equipment provided includes US Coast Guard approved PFDs in the appropriate sizes.

Cost

\$260 for each session. Lifeguard provided.

Campfire

Campfire wood with starter fuel will be set up for the group by Bonclarken staff. The group is responsible for supplying matches, lighting the campfire, and extinguishing the campfire.

Cost

\$25 per campfire

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Recreation session length determined by group size, special needs, and ability level.
